

GM Heritage Center Visitor's Guide

If you were unable to visit the GM Heritage Center, you can still get to learn and experience it. You will do this by creating a visitor's guide or brochure for the GM Heritage Center.

Design this on any program you choose, or by hand.

Brochure must be made out of 8.5x11 paper, however you can choose if you would like to do a tri-fold, bi-fold, or leave it full page.

1. Layout: Think about your layout. Look at example brochures or guides for ideas.
2. Research: The purpose of a brochure is to sell something or to inform, so research what the GM Heritage Center is all about.
3. Writing: Your writing should be clear, informative yet to the point. Watch spelling and grammar and put everything in your own words. (No copying and pasting.)
4. Pictures: Show pictures that would be interesting or descriptive to someone not familiar with the center.
5. Neatness: Make sure your guide/ brochure is neat, easy to read yet eye catching and interesting.
6. Name and date: As always, be sure to include. 😊
