

DREAM HOUSE FRONT ELEVATION SKETCH

You started this project doing some elevation sketches. Now that you have developed your floor plan in CAD your initial idea may have altered. Therefore another sketch of the front elevation of your house will be helpful

1. After you have completed the Schematic CAD Floor Plans of your house, sketch what the front elevation would look like. Print your 1st and 2nd Floor Plans to 8.5x11" sheets so you have them in front of you to reference.

Items to address when sketching

- Windows that appear on the floor plan appear in the same location on the elevation.
- Window mullion pattern
- Doors that appear on the floor plan appear in the same location on the elevation.
- Door style
- Façade materials (Siding, shingles, brick, trim, etc.)
- Roof slope

If you find that you think your elevation looks strange or funny due to window or door locations on your floor plan, this is the time to change them ☺

2. Once you are complete with your sketch, Title it FRONT ELEVATION, sign and date it and turn it in along with your 8.5x11" 1st and 2nd Floor Plans for review.
