Vehicle Design Sketching

Create sketches of your designed vehicle. In order to help you sketch, feel free to download images of your vehicle to sketch over using vellum. You may also try to free-hand it completely, but it would still be helpful to have the image of the vehicle to look at. Review the tutorials and drawing templates shown in class for additional help. Keep the following tips in mind.

- 1. This is sketching, not technical drafting. Do not be afraid to make mistakes. Do not use drafting tools.
- 2. Do not tape your paper down. This is sketching not technical drafting.
- 3. Keep all your sketches. Even the "bad" ones.
- 4. Sketch quickly, too much thought and you will end up focusing more on the drawing than the design.
- 5. Use varying lineweights to help make your sketch "read".
- 6. Sign and date every sketch.

Final Requirements:

- 1. Create a sketch (perspective) or sketches (front-top-side view) to fully describe your vehicle.
- 2. Turn in all sketches made during this process.
